MAKE OUR SCHOOLS SAFE CLUBS



SUPPORT ALYSSA'S LAW

Alyssa's Law is critical legislation addressing the issue of law enforcement response time when a life-threatening emergency occurs because time equals life. The law calls for the installation of silent panic alarms that are directly linked to law enforcement, so in case of any emergency lifesaving help arrives on the scene as quickly as possible, to mitigate the threat and triage any possible victims.

Alyssa's Law has passed in New Jersey, Florida and New York. Legislation is in-progress within Georgia, Oregon, and Texas.

THE SAFER SCHOOLS ACT

This bill establishes a pilot program through which the Department of Justice must award grants to public elementary and secondary schools to conduct independent facility security risk assessments and make hard security improvements. This will offer federal funding to bolster the physical security of school campuses which will save student lives.

The time is NOW to pass the Safer Schools Act HR 2717! This bipartisan, common sense legislation is meant to prevent future tragedies in our schools and ensure our students are being taught in the safest environments possible.

The Safer Schools Act is in desperate need of additional co-sponsors in order to be codified into federal law. This is where you can help! We must contact our representatives and urge them to show support for the Safer Schools Act.
