

# **SUPPORT ALYSSA'S LAW**

Alyssa's Law is critical legislation addressing the issue of law enforcement response time when a life-threatening emergency occurs because time equals life.



The legislation has passed in Florida, Oklahoma, Tennessee, Texas, New York, New Jersey and Utah. Alyssa's Law is inprogress within Oregon and Pennsylvania.

### FEDERAL LEGISLATION

In 2023, the bipartisan <u>ALYSSA Act (H.R. 4999)</u> was introduced in the U.S. House of Representatives. This life-saving legislation, introduced by Congressman Josh Gottheimer, mandates and funds silent panic alarms for public schools in the United States. The <u>Strengthening Our Schools (SOS) Act of 2024 (H.R. 5000)</u> was also introduced to increase investment in more well-trained School Resource Officers so that every school has a first responder already on campus in the event of a critical incident. Similarly, the <u>Safer Schools Act (H.R. 3618)</u> was introduced to assess and solve risks in our schools.

These three pieces of legislation are in desperate need of additional co-sponsors in order to be codified into federal law. This is where you can help!

We must contact our representatives and urge them to co-sponsor support for H.R. 4999, H.R. 5000, and H.R. 3618.
